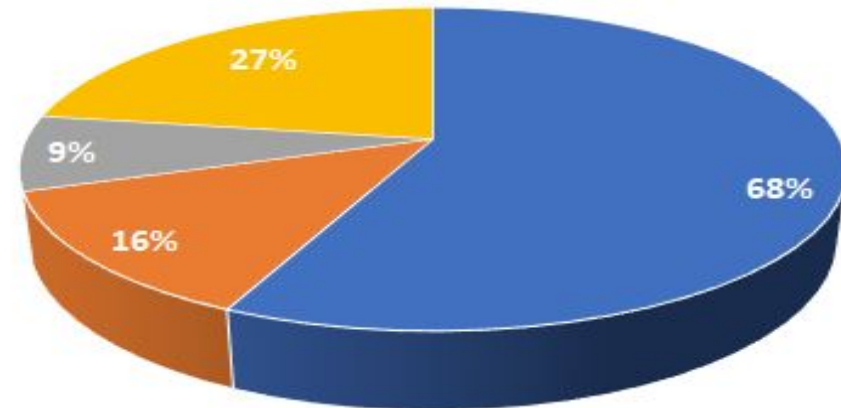




# Caller Profile

Caller Group Type % 2019

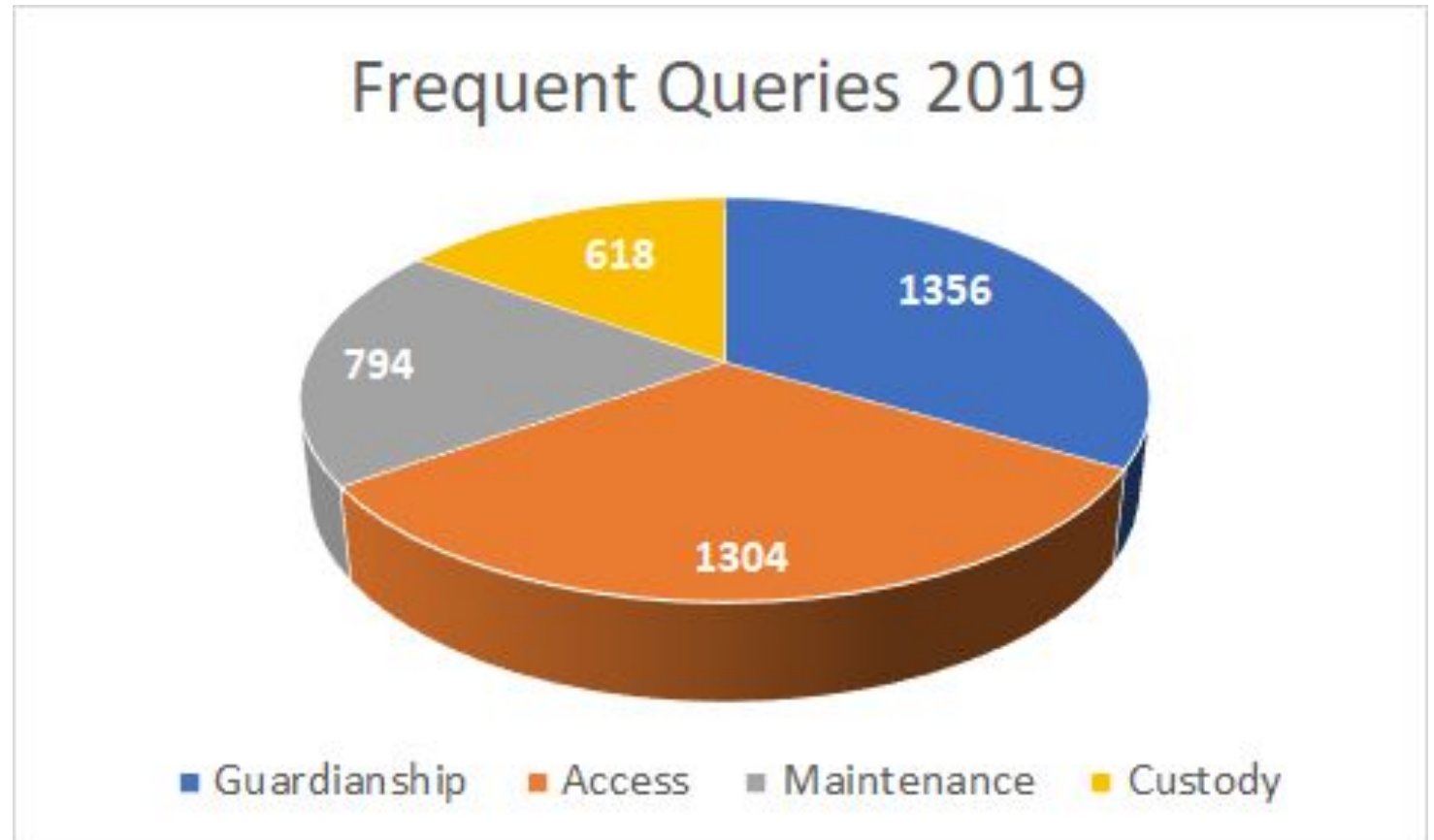

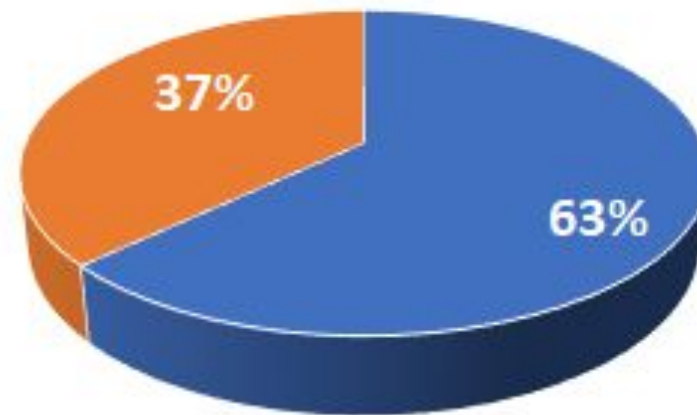
